Qualifications:

- College degree or equivalent.
- Prevoist (Level 4) or Master Certification as a foil coach from any accredited institution: FIE, USFCA, Italian fencing Federation, French or any other recognized national fencing entity.
- Understand principals of sport pedagogy and training for high performance athletes.
- Proficient in English.
- Eligible to work in the United States.
- Able to teach beginning to elite group classes to athletes of all ages.
- Be a team player and able to help build a long-term program.
- Have proven experience as a foil coach and competitive experience at the national and international level.
- Pass USA Fencing Background Check and comply with SafeSport requirements from the USFA.
- Be an active coach member from the United States Fencing Association.
- Ability to communicate with participants, guide and assist them during group instruction and fencing time.
- Candidate must be enthusiastic, self-motivated, reliable, and communicate kindly with children.
- At least two letters of recommendations of good moral behavior and sportsmanship among peers, coaches, or mentors.
- Knowledge of all Safe Sport rules in the USA related to the proper handling of children, for the mental and physical safety of all participants

Responsibilities:

- Responsibilities: Teach beginning, intermediate to elite foil group classes to children and adults.
- Design, and implement a yearly training plan, following athletic periodization cycles with objectives and goals for Elite fencers.
- Create and implement individual and group lessons to be implemented in the club.
- Create and run new fencing programs in the community and at different school districts in Central Ohio .
- Help set the direction of the Foil competitive program according to Profencing's vision.
- Coach at summer and winter camps as needed.
- Travel and coach at regional or national competitions as required, according to the USFA schedule.
- Help in the maintenance of equipment and of the building, ensuring the club is always clean, safe, and ready for practice.
- Assist with warm up games and activities related to fencing footwork, drills, and fencing games.
- Ensure participants follow all fencing and safety rules.
- During fencing drills and exercises help participants to adapt correct fencing form and ensure they are following and understanding the coaches' instructions.
- Supervise participants during playtime and breaks in the playground.
- Communicate with head coach or instructors about any observations or matters related to behavioral issues that requires immediately attention.
- Promote a healthy and friendly environment of respect among members, parents, and coaches.
